Project No: 2019-2-CY02-KA205-001641

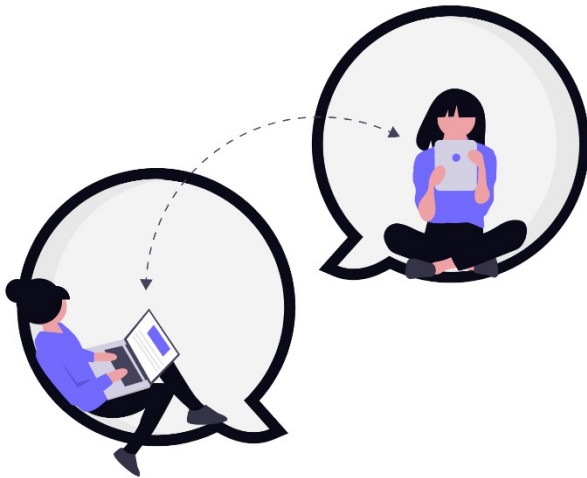

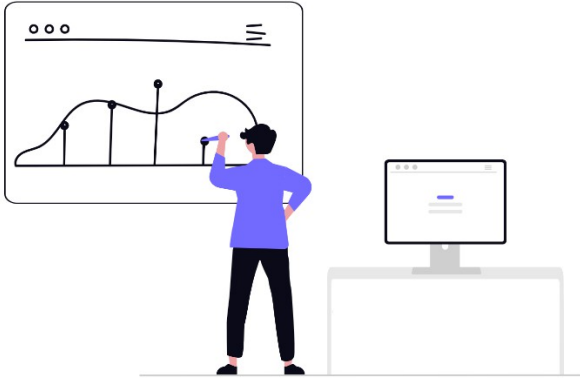
This project trains young people to identify fake news, misinformation and online manipulation. BASD provided media literacy workshops and created practical tools for critical thinking.

Project No: 2025-1-RO01-KA220-YOU-000353503

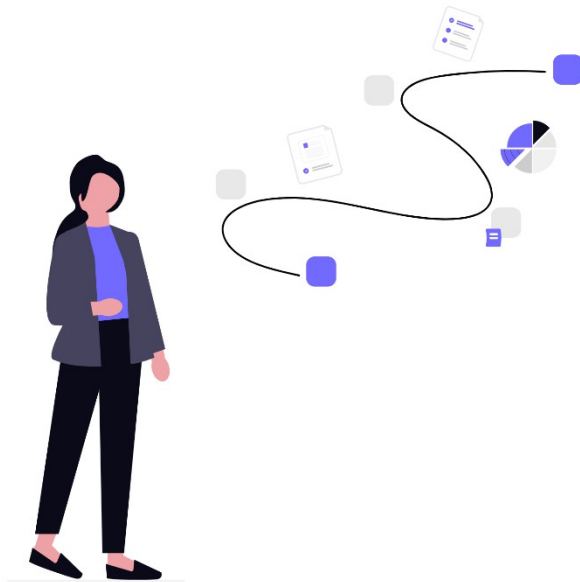
The project encourages young women to take active roles in the circular economy through training and hands-on initiatives. BASD contributes expertise in sustainability and supports young female leaders.
